to terminate this Agreement and upon the expiry of the said period the Term shall

15. Compensation If this Agreement is terminated by either the County Council or the Parish Council pursuant to clause 14 of this Agreement the County Council shall pay compensation to the Parish Council of a sum equal to the Capital Contribution reduced by 1/60 for each year of the Term which has elapsed or pro rata for any part of a year which has elapsed
The County Council hereby permits and the Governing Body confirms so far as it is able to do so the Parish Council and all persons expressly or impliedly authorised by the Parish Council (in common with the County Council and the Governing Body and all others similarly entitled) to enter upon the School Premises and the Facilities for the purpose of exercising its rights and fulfilling its obligations under this Agreement
17. Interest
For the avoidance of doubt it is hereby declared and Facilities is made or intended to be made by this Agreement
18. <u>Agreement to be personal</u> This Agreement is personal to the parties to it and shall not be capable of assignment novation or any other dealing without the written consent of all of the parties hereto
19. <u>Variations</u> This Agreement may only be varied in writing by a document executed by all of the
parties hereto
Any notice to be given in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing and must be sent by first class recorded delivery to the party due to receive the notice at its address set out in this Agreement




